Regarding...

Continuing Education Training

Attention Wastewater Operators.....



The Board of Certification has unanimously voted to propose regulation changes to the Delaware Legislatures with regards to Continuing Education Training and your wastewater operators license. Under the proposed changes you are still required to obtain twenty (20) contact hours of continuing education training every two (2) years. However at least ten (10) of the twenty (20) contact hours would be required to relate directly to the wastewater industry.

While this is not a regulatory requirement at this time, we highly encourage all licensed wastewater operators to consider this when signing up for and taking continuing education training.

How will I know if a class is a approved/denied and if it is directly related to the wastewater industry?

The Board of Certification and the Surface Water Discharges Section have created two reports:

- 1) Approved Continuing Education Training for Wastewater Operators
- 2) Continuing Education Training Not Approved for Wastewater Operators

Where can I obtain a copy of the reports?

Both reports will be available in paper copy at the Surface Water Discharges Section and electronically on the Surface Water Discharges Section website.

How do I locate the Surface Water Discharges Section website and how often will the reports be updated?

The Surface Water Discharges Section website is located at www.dnrec.state.de.us/water2000/Sections/SurfWater/DWRSurfWat.htm and will be updated monthly.
